The animation crew consisted of 120 members with a total of 109,440 frames taken for the movie. How does the effect work?

Stop motion animation is a very long, detailed process. Inanimate objects are used, like puppets, clay, or 2D objects and are physically moved by hand in small increments. Each time an object is slightly moved, a frame is captured one at a time. In the end, each frame will be put together one after another in quick viewing, The images will appear consecutive and will have the same concept as a flipbook .

Steps to make stop motion animation

- Create a Plan- What will your story be about? What items/objects will you need? What transitions will you use? Where will you shoot? What will your background be? What will be your desired lighting?Create a storyboard or moodboard
- 2. Number of Frames-The higher number of frames you have will result in a smooth, continuous look. About 10-15 frames per second.
- 3. Props- Figure out what props you need to create or gather. Practically any inanimate object will work.
- 4. Set everything up- A flat surface works best and will be easier to manipulate the objects. Set camera to position you want to shoot.

Steps to making stop motion animation

5..Shoot scenes in still frames- Begin with one scene at a time. Set prop up, take a shot, and move it slightly. Take another shot and repeat process on all inanimate objects you want to move.

6.Edit- Combine all still images into a video
